### **Setting the Record Straight: The Collective Food Yard & Garden**

There have been claims about the Town of Fort White "singling out" and "selectively enforcing" codes or "attacking" The Collective Food Yard & Garden.

Also, allegations that the Town Council hindered their planned Fourth of July event. These claims are intentionally misleading.

#### Here are the facts:

- \* The Collective Food Yard & Garden is not in compliance with several conditions of a settlement agreement with the Town of Fort White signed on December 16, 2024.
- \* Discussions about their landscaping concerned compliance with their site plan, a condition of that agreement, not "too much" planting.
- \* The Collective Food Yard & Garden never requested permission for a Fourth of July event. Main Street of Fort White did propose an event, which the Council supported, but raised safety concerns about law enforcement and a trained road crossing guard at SR 47 for a safe event for the community.

Our community thrives on shared facts and mutual respect. We are dedicated to explaining our decisions and listening to your concerns.


